

<p>2) Offering of Doctor of Education in Educational Management (EdD) in the Tomas Oppus Campus tied up with Tra Vinh University (TVU), Vietnam</p>	<p>Foreign students - Inbound</p>	<p>2015-2016: EdD- 9</p> <p>2016-2017: EdD- 16</p> <p>2017-2018: EdD- 8</p>	<p>2nd Sem 2015- 2016 to 2017- 2018</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">IMPLEMENTATION SCHEME For Doctor of Education in Educational Management for International Students in SLSU-Tomas Oppus, Southern Leyte, the Philippines</p> <p>The Southern Leyte State University (SLSU), Southern Leyte, Philippines and the Tra Vinh University (TVU), Tra Vinh Province, Vietnam have entered into a Bilateral Co-operation Agreement on September 1, 2009 at InWent, Stressmann Str. 92, 10963 Berlin, specifying the setting up of Master in Management as an extension program of SLSU in TVU.</p> <p>Up to now, the two institutions have entered some other bilateral agreements in joint research, international recruitment agent in Vietnam for SLSU, which hosts Graduate Students (GS) from Vietnam recommended by TVU. Other developments include a Memorandum of Understanding between SLSU and Vietnam Association of Community Colleges (VACC) signed on May 20, 2013 at Hanoi, Vietnam.</p> <p>In particular, the Ed.D. major in Educational Management is a post-graduate degree program which provides the students with immense understanding on the principles, theories and practices as applied in education, and develops necessary advanced skills, knowledge and experiences to effect change and improve education process. It stresses the role of teachers and school managers and related experiences of leaders in promoting excellence in education in the local and global setting. Its offering in the international arena is its response to the demand of a call for borderless Southeast Asia in 2015 and beyond.</p> <p>The program consists of six advanced foundation courses, eight major courses, three cognate courses, (all with three – unit per course), and dissertation writing (dissertation agenda – Phase I with 6 units and dissertation Phase II with 6 units) with 63 – unit requirement. Within the period of completion of academic requirements, two (2) advanced English courses will be offered for students to enhance the communication skills of students in both oral and written discourse before they go to SLSU to study.</p> <p>The entire program shall be delivered in English as medium of instruction in either real or virtual scheme or their combination; either in the Philippines or in partner country or a third country depending on the preference of the majority of the students and the administration of the two institutions. Despite of the flexibility of class venue, the quality of the program must be ensured by the standard of SLSU in terms of teaching program, faculty staff and qualified dissertation.</p> <p>As part of the agreement, this program will be valid for five years wherein formative and summative assessments shall be done for improvement. Base on the results of assessment, the program can enhance its operation strategies. It has the opportunity for extension and its termination can only be done in writing, three months before the expiration month. However, if the agreement ceases to be effective</p>

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND COOPERATION BETWEEN UTAH STATE UNIVERSITY Logan, Utah, U.S.A. AND SOUTHERN LEYTE STATE UNIVERSITY Sogod, Philippines


Utah State University and Southern Leyte State University, to develop an academic exchange and cooperation program in education and research, have agreed to the following:

1. Based on the principles of mutual benefit and respect for each other's independence, the two institutions will foster:
 - a) Student and academic and administrative staff exchanges
 - b) Short-term programs for students
 - c) Joint research activities
 - d) Exchanges of academic material
2. In order to carry out the above-mentioned activities, a detailed plan may be agreed to upon consultation between the two institutions.
3. It is implicit that each and every activity undertaken under this agreement is approved by the appropriate officials at each institution and must fall within each institution's academic and fiscal constraints.
4. This agreement shall be effective on and after the date of its signing by the authorized representatives of the two institutions, and shall remain in force until either party wishes to terminate. In order to terminate, six months written notice must be issued.
5. This agreement may be modified at any time after due consultation between the two institutions.
6. If this agreement is provided in the language of both signatories, both documents have equal validity.

Other universities in ASEAN Community, upon signing this agreement, are recognized as Participating Universities. Non-ASEAN academic institutions are welcomed to join the network as Honorary Members.</p> <p>Host University, Founding Universities, Participating Universities, and Honorary Members are Member Universities and have similar rights and authorities in sharing academic exchange information among NETSIM members.
